A little about Daylight Saving Time

(you probably didn't know)

OK, you may have known this but I didn't so here's a few interesting facts since this year it's moving up two weeks and back one week. First of all, the official name is Daylight Saving(no S) Time. The original idea was proposed by Benjamin Franklin as a way to conserve energy. The idea never really got far in the early 1800's but by the first World War, in 1916 Daylight Saving Time was begun in Germany and Austria. Most other European countries followed in 1917. It wasn't until 1918 the idea caught on in the U.S. It was so unpopular the act was repealed two years later. Between Feb. 2 1942 and Sept. 30, 1945 FDR instituted Daylight Saving Time year round and called it War Time. The Uniform Time Act of 1966 was designed to finally put the whole country on the same program. In 1986 Congress identified the first Sunday in April and the last Sunday in October as the defining dates for Daylight Saving Time. For the third time this year it will begin the second Sunday of March and end the first Sunday of November. Estimates by different groups claim moving the clock saves as much as 3% of the total energy consumption of the country. So there you go.
