NIOSA (Night in Old San Antonio)

This is the largest non-parade event during Fiesta.

The forerunner to NIOSA was a small one-night street fair called the Indian Festival originally held in 1937 at San Jose Mission. The purpose was to raise money for the San Antonio Conservation Society's projects and to make people aware of our cultural heritage. When the event was moved to the river, the event became known as the River Festival or the River Jubilee. The Fiesta Association asked the society to move the event into Fiesta week.

The society saw the event as a huge fundraiser. NIOSA officially joined Fiesta on April 21, 1948, when the event moved to La Villita. It began as a one night event held on Tuesday. Over the years, nights were added. In 1958, the fourth night was added.

At the first NIOSA, the only food served was barbecue, beans and coffee. The event also included an arts and craft show, a food fair and a festival.

Now the event takes place over four nights. Exotic ethnic food dishes, music and dance characterize the celebration.

It takes 16,000 volunteers to put on NIOSA each year.
